

Chinese Juniper Tree



Hardiness zones: 3-9. In its tree form, the Chinese juniper naturally grows into a conical shape with a spread of about 20 feet at maturity, and requires no pruning to keep its shape. Characteristic of junipers, juvenile leaves and adult leaves have a distinctly different appearance. The bark has a flaky appearance.

Instructions:

1. Soak in hot tap water, let stand in water for 6 hours
2. Place seeds in a plastic bag and keep at 65°F to 75°F for 90 days.
3. Place bag in refrigerator for 90 days.
4. Sow seed in ¼" deep.
5. Mulch the seed bed
6. Keep moist, provide some shade.
